

Curriculum Vitae Camilla Modéer, Sweden

Camilla Modéer is elected member/fellow of the Royal Swedish Academy of Engineering Sciences, IVA, since 1995 and is from 2012 acting as Senior Advisor to the Academy.

She initiated and established the Swedish NGO Vetenskap & Allmänhet, VA (Public & Science) and was Secretary General from the start in early 2002 until 2011, leaving a well-established and recognized organization. VA is a leading knowledge hub and partner for dialogue between researchers, different sectors of society and the public. VA is partner in several EU-projects including, RRI, coordinating Researchers' Night in Sweden from the start 2006.

From 1991 to 2001 she was director of Research, Education and Innovation policies at the Federation of Swedish Industries. In close collaboration with member industrial companies the actual and future needs of knowledge and competence were analysed. On this basis policies were developed and efforts to influence national and European politicians were made. A number of activities were performed in order to change attitudes and actions of government, Parliament, EU, Universities, Research councils and Public Institutions. She was actively involved in the Business Europe (Unice).

Before that she served as Vice President of the National Board of Universities and Colleges with a number of responsibilities ranging from strategic development, organisation, international relations, computer net efficiency, monitoring research and education etc. Earlier she was committee manager and rapporteur in a wide variety of fields. She got her Master of Engineering and PhD from the Royal Institute of Technology in Stockholm where she also served as lecturer for a few years.

She is and has been a member of several boards of companies, universities, public agencies and organizations in Sweden and of several EU and European committees. This includes serving as national representative on several committees of EU, eg Erasmus, co-chairing High Level Executive Group on Foresight etc. She was engaged in organising the very first ESOF 2004 and has been participating in all ESOFs. She has been co-chair of ESF Science in Society committee. She is and has been chairing a number of Advisory Boards in disciplines like Nanotechnology to Brain research.

She is the author of a large number of expert reports, newspaper articles and other publications and has given numerous speeches and appearances at conferences and in different public media. Languages: Swedish, English, French (fair), German (fair)
